

# Infant's Jumper from The Lux Book 1941



## MATERIALS :

3 ozs. 3-ply wool ; 1 pair each Nos. 10 and 12 needles ; 6 small buttons ; a medium-size crochet hook.

## MEASUREMENTS :

Length from shoulder to lower edge, 10 inches ; around underarms, 20 inches ; sleeve seam, 7½ inches.

## TENSION OF KNITTING :

7 sts. and 10 rows to 1 inch.

## BACK :

With No. 12 needles cast on 70 sts and work 16 rows in rib of K. 1, P. 1, (working 1st row into backs of sts.). Change to No. 10 needles and work 54 rows in stocking-st. Continue in stocking-st., casting off 4 at beginning of next 2 rows, then K. 2 tog. at beginning of next 6 rows. (56 sts.). Work 4 rows even in stocking-st.

83rd row (right side facing)—K. 4, (P. 1, K. 1) 3 times, P. 1, K. 7, (P. 1, K. 1) 3 times, P. 1, K. 6, (P. 1, K. 1) 3 times, P. 1, K. 7, (P. 1, K. 1) 3 times, P. 1, K. 4.

84th row—P. 4, (K. 1, P. 1) 3 times, K. 1, P. 7, (K. 1, P. 1) 3 times, K. 1, P. 6, (K. 1, P. 1) 3 times, K. 1, P. 7, (K. 1, P. 1) 3 times, K. 1, P. 4. Repeat last 2 rows 9 times. Cast off fairly loosely right across row in ribbing.

## FRONT :

Work exactly as for Back.

## SLEEVES (both alike) :

With No. 12 needles cast on (loosely) 42 sts. and work 16 rows in rib of K. 1, P. 1, (working 1st row into backs of sts.). Change to No. 10 needles. Work 10 rows in stocking-st. Continue in stocking-st., increasing 1 st. at beginning and end of next and every following 10th row till there are 52 sts. on needle. Work 7 rows even in stocking-st. Now K. 2 tog. at beginning of every row till 36 sts. remain, then K. 2 tog. at each end of every row till 10 sts. remain. Cast off.

## TO MAKE UP :

Join shoulders together ½ inch in from side edge. Work 1 row of d.c. round both shoulders (18 sts. on either side). Sew 6 small buttons on Back (3 either side) and make loops to correspond on Front. Join side and sleeve seams and sew in sleeves. Embroider or sew motifs on Front of Pullover if desired.
